Take Coaching to a Whole New Level

Effective leaders use their coaching skills to guide teachers to reflect on their own practice, help them to identify problems, create their own solutions and encourage them to accept responsibility for their own professional development and teaching practice. Coaching has a powerful impact in the classroom to improve practice and outcomes and for whole school improvement, supporting professional dialogue and learning.

The Level 2 Advanced Coaching Skills course is delivered by Will Thomas, founder of Vision for Learning and best selling author of 'Coaching Solutions'. The Level 2 course builds on the Introduction to Coaching course or is suitable for staff who have already completed some form of training in coaching. The course is intensely practical and is intended to give you experience of all aspects of the coaching skill set. The programme combines elements of coaching with neuro-linguistic programming (NLP), advanced questioning and rapport building skills with a bonus session on mindfulness for coaches.

- How to generate motivating targets
- When to ask questions and when to stay silent
- Precision questioning techniques so that your questions have greater impact
- How and why people construct problem states of mind and how to use highly targeted questioning to help them make change
- Conversational techniques to help people break out of "stuck states" and develop their own solutions
- Techniques to build high levels of confidence in yourself and others
- Techniques for dealing with challenging people
- How to fine tune your senses to pick up even more information about what others are thinking
- How to promote relaxation in others through careful construction of language
- The potential for wider organisational coaching approaches and how to develop a whole school CPD model based around coaching
