Teaching and Learning Development Days

The Teaching and Learning Development Days give different cohorts of staff the opportunity to experience immersion days within other school settings. These will be hosted and run by some of the 12 partnership schools across the alliance.

The days will be offered on a reciprocal basis in order to be cost neutral for those schools wishing to participate.

Programmes will be bespoke for cohorts in order to support a personalised programme of CPD that aligns to performance management targets and/or professional goals.

Penrice Academy will host a maximum of 5 teaching and learning development days across the scholastic year. The dates of the sessions that Penrice Academy will host are below. Finer detail including programme overviews will be developed in collaboration with the host school and the experiences/needs of the visiting cohort.

This is an excellent opportunity for teachers/leaders to observe practice and develop their skills through observation and reflection in another school. Schools choosing to offer Teaching and Learning development days will host approximately 10 teachers per day.

Teaching and Learning Development Days will include areas such as;

- Creative and inspirational teaching – opportunities for observation and reflection to develop excellence in practice at any stage of a teachers' career
- Specific subject knowledge development days for early career teachers/NQTs
- Post 16 teaching, including teaching to the top/Grade 9 teaching approaches to promote challenge for most able students
- Specific curriculum days, Maths, Science and English to develop planning, practice and a challenging curriculum at KS3/KS4
- Observing highly effective teaching in relation to pace, challenge and questioning
- An aspiring middle leaders' day
- An aspiring senior leaders' day
- Supporting senior leaders who are new to the role
- Effective teaching and support of SEND/PP students

Each day will be carefully planned and include observations of teaching in the setting, with opportunities to reflect with senior staff hosting the days.
